Apologies: Bruce McLauchlan who included the following ideas for attracting businesses, residents and tourists into our area:

The natural attributes of the waterways are not being promoted in modern sports / recreational environment. A mardi gras parade just doesn't cut it anymore with depletion of sense of community in the town. We cant compete for the long stay tourist against low airfare /strong dollar, people do not take their ritual annual holidays at The Entrance anymore. The day / weekend visitor is the target

The area doesn't have enough natural uniqueness, to warrant promoting, so it has to be event driven, to make the people come. Events should be aimed at local residents as much as tourists, to make viable. Some more modern approaches to current sports / activities for weekend events should be considered -

If say the Town Centre or Council could assist local sporting clubs in admin promotion and organisation of events, the following could be considered >

- Local businesses would come on board if proffessionaly promoted with sponsership,
- Often the first of these events are hard to get up , and need some professional admin backing
- Bike track promote with a community ride / race around the lake annual event -
- pram pushing fun run/ walk charity event ,extremely family friendly environment promote and highlight great place to stay/ maybe move to and raise a family promote our play areas on foreshore
- an **annual triathlon** event approach local trainers High tide Fitness to organise they attend a lot of fun runs /endurance challenges

- create an endurance event (see google Tough Guy challenge or Warrior Dash races at held at Glenworth valley huge roll up literally thousands of competitors attended ,
- We have the open space and beaches to do these events example the Crackneck challenge ? run from Toowoon Bay to Crack neck and back along Shelly Beach Bateau Bay ? or Magenta Challenge
- major surfing contest with new clubhouse amenity at Shelley Beach huge growing sport
- Stand up paddleboard race growing sport Toukley to The Entrance in summer with NE winds annual event or annual ocean race approach local stand up paddle boarders club (just google stand up paddle board race and see events world wide 500 competitors in some events even the canals in cities in Europe are hosting this new sport be an early mover
- ocean ski paddle race ocean endurance events the surf clubs are often looking for challenges out of competition season during winter - Terrigal to The Entrance a perfect short course run ,
- Fish feeding from the Fishermans wharf (GOOGLE Naval museum at Huskison for fish feeding success story) traders could sell pellets create a limited no fish zone in front of Fishermans wharf area low cost family attraction that compliments
 - existing pelican feeding activity simple , easy to impliment , adds to spectacle of boardwalk
- Fish Feeding sanctuary at Toowoon Bay Shark Hole (southern protected bay area) with support of surf club cafe bread scraps see Neds Beach Lord Howe as successful tourist model hugely popular low cost kiddie attraction nothing done like it
 - locally, would be easy to impliment and compliment surf club cafe commercial operations with leftover scraps and sale of pellets - Great kids snorkelling venue, shallow, protected partrolled -, its called shark hole so catchy name for tourism -

- would only take 2 signs either end of beach showing no fishing as capital outlay , and co operation of cafe / surf club volunteers to feed fish at designated time on the high tide

- Jet ski races an ocean endurance race from Sydney to The Entrance Fishermans Wharf / Picnic Point news worthy with great arial coverage of town - - we still have jetski areas which Sydney doesnt have anymore not promoted
- tagged fish competition with major prizes , (my father gave away a block of land to 400 pounds and a builder gave away a house to total value 1000 pounds in the 1960s - insurance was taken out to cover losses- Ampol was major sponsor)
- Better use of Memorial park for caravan, boating, fishing, lifesylye recreation show weekend displays
- **drumming events alternate lifestyle shows**, natural therapies, health, fitness, promotional days see Rhythm Hut in Gosford website for growing popularity of this activity (showing my old hippy background now)
- Car shows / bike show destination ride / drive approach enthusiast clubs
- Cheap eats night mid week wth group of restaurant traders promoted ?
