Brick and Concrete

The earlier you remove graffiti after it occurs; the easier it is to remove. Graffiti on the back of painted road signs is removed easily using the **SoSafe BLUE LABEL Graffiti Remover** for non-painted surfaces.



- 1. Read safety precautions!
- 2. Surface must be clean and <u>DRY</u> (blue label does not work on wet surfaces).
- 3. Test an in conspicuous part of surface to test for product reaction.
- 4. Wipe over graffiti with nylon scourer.
- 5. Apply product undiluted to graffiti.
- 6. Allow at least 1 minute for product to penetrate graffiti.
- 7. Scrub graffiti with scourer and then wipe residue off with paper towel.
- 8. Repeat steps 5 to 7 (as required).
- Rinse / wipe all treated areas with water to remove graffiti remover (this will deactivate the product).

(RECOMMENDED) Apply SoSafe Safety Shield to protect against future graffiti.
