The earlier you remove graffiti after it occurs; the easier it is to remove. Graffiti on painted road signs is removed easily using the

SoSafe YELLOW LABEL Graffiti Remover for painted surfaces.



- 1. Read safety precautions!
- 2. Surface must be clean and <u>DRY</u> (yellow label does not work on wet surfaces).
- 3. Test an in conspicuous part of surface to test for product reaction.
- 4. Apply product undiluted to graffiti.
- 5. Allow at least 1 minute for product to penetrate graffiti.
- 6. Wipe graffiti off with paper towel or white rag.
- 7. Repeat steps 4 to 6 (as required).
- 8. Rinse / wipe all treated areas with water to remove graffiti remover (this will deactivate the product).

(RECOMMENDED) Apply SoSafe Safety Shield to protect against future graffiti.

Glitz Paint Removing Wipes can also be used.
