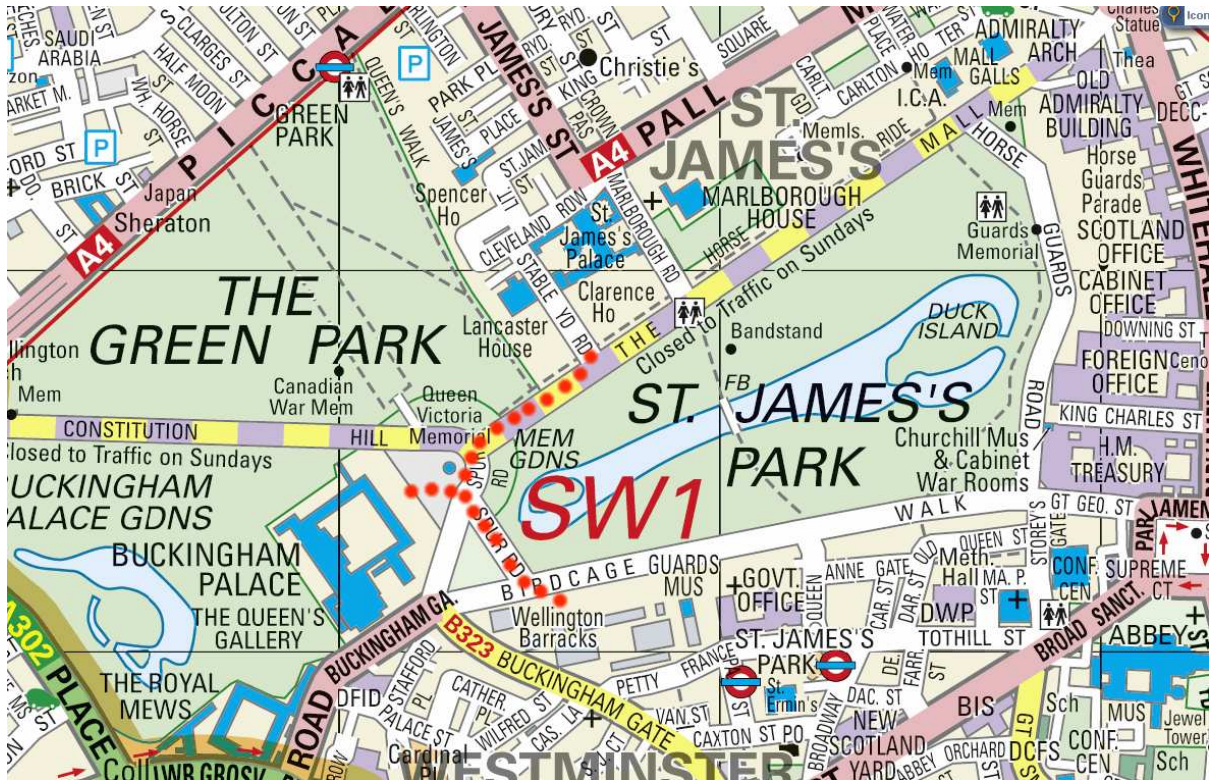

The Queen's Gallery



The **Queen's Gallery** is located within **Buckingham Palace**, the principal residence of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and one of the world's most famous buildings. The gallery exhibits items from the prestigious Royal Collection, an eclectic collection of art and other treasures, which is held by the Queen in trust for the nation (rather than being the personal property of the monarch). A typical visit should last around one hour to ninety minutes.

The Queen's Gallery was re-opened to the public in 2002 and has proved to be extremely popular with London's tourists. Indeed visiting The Queen's Gallery is one of the essential London attractions for any visitors that have a passion for art or a fascination with the British monarchy.

A visit to the Queen's Gallery can be combined with witnessing the Changing of the Guard and, if your visit takes place between July and September, the tour of Buckingham Palace.
